Foreword

This document contains a compendium of the achievements in the last three and half years of Distinguished Senator Uba Sani as a Senator representing Kaduna Central.

These achievements are in the area of Education, Health, security, empowerment and training programs, provision of physical infrastructure for schools, Communities, and scholarships amongst others.

Historically, the Distinguished Senator introduced the Zonal Constituency Office for the Seven Local Governments under his Constituency headed by a Chief Constituency Officer. The Zonal Constituency Office and the other Local Government Constituency Offices have a total of 35 employees which ranges from Technical staff, support, administrative and clerical staff.

It is a record book of massive projects and achievements sponsored by Distinguished Senator Uba Sani. Every project has been carried out based on the needs of the locations they were situated. This compendium reflects the desire of the people of Kaduna Central Senatorial District.

Early Life

Uba Sani protested against military authoritarianism in Nigeria, leaving behind a footprint of bravery and patriotism. He deployed his organization and networking skills in creating a strategic base for the pro-democracy movement in Northern Nigeria. He also made ample use of his civil society organization, the Movement for Freedom and Justice, to champion the rights of the underprivileged and offered them unfettered access to justice. He has held successfully the roles of the National Vice Chairman (North) of Campaign for Democracy (CD) and Deputy National Chairman (North) of the Joint Action Committee (JACON) led by the legendary Chief Gani Fawehinmi, SAN.

Politics

Sani went into politics after the return of Democracy in Nigeria in 1999, and supported the People's Democratic Party presidential candidate, Chief Olusegun Obasanjo. After winning the presidential election, Sani was appointed Special Assistant on public affairs to the president.

He also worked at the Federal Capital Territory Administration (FCTA) on some advisory roles to the then FCT Minister, Nasir Ahmad El-Rufai and the Kaduna State Ministry of Works, housing and Transport. In 2011, Sani contested in the People's Democratic Party primaries for the Kaduna Central Senatorial seat but he lost the primaries, and in 2015, he was appointed by the Kaduna state governor, Malam Nasir Ahmad El-Rufai as the Special Adviser, Political and Intergovernmental Affairs. However, in 2019, Sani showed interest and contested for the second time for the Kaduna Central senatorial seat under the ruling political party, the All Progressives Congress (APC), and was elected senator during the February 2019 Nigeria general elections.

In May 2022, Senator Uba Sani won the APC primary election to become the gubernatorial flagbearer of the All Progressives Congress (APC) in Kaduna State.

Bills Sponsored


Senator Uba Sani is Currently serving as the Chairman, Senate Committee on Banking, Insurance and other Financial Institutions. His sheer brilliance and resilience have fuelled the birth of several reformative legislations with 32 sponsored Bills to his credit. 5 Bills have been passed by the 9th National Assembly, and 2 assented to by the President. The Bills passed include the Federal College of Education Giwa Kaduna State (Est. Etc.) Bill 2019 (SB.121), Federal Medical Centre Rigassa, Kaduna State (Est., Etc.) Bill 2019 (SB.169), Firearms Act Cap F28 LFN (Amendment) Bill 2020 (SB. 549); Asset Management Corporation of Nigeria Act (Amendment) Bill 2021 (SB. 669) and the renowned Banking and Other Financial Institutions Act (Amendment) Bill 2020 which were both Assented by the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

Humanitarian Life

Uba Sani founded the Uba Sani Foundation in 2018. The foundation's mission is to promote increased access to good healthcare services, education, and improved livelihood for the underprivileged in Nigeria. The foundation uses available resources and expertise to provide assistance to the less privileged in Education, Healthcare, Vocational Skills and Empowerment.

Senator Uba Sani's representation in the senate is also largely seen as a continuation of his love for service to humanity, as a human rights and prodemocracy activist, businessman and philanthropist. His devotion to helping people has endeared him to a lot of people in Kaduna State and indeed several Nigerians across the country.

The foundation developed a business plan as well as registered businesses of all the 100 beneficiaries in order for them to operate legitimately.

Over 5000 women and youths have benefited from the skills acquisition programme across the seven local government areas in the zone.

The foundation also empowers young women and men with vocational business skills to reduce extreme poverty, such as fire outbreaks, floods and other calamities.

Health

Over 50 Million Naira has been spent on the provision of free medical testing and treatment of the vulnerable in the zone.

Funding

The Uba Sani Foundation collaborated with key agencies like Bank of Agriculture BOA and NIRSAL Microfinance Bank to assess low-interest loans of over N500 million to revive or recapitalize their businesses.

In a bid to deepen financial inclusion and create opportunities for access to credit facilities for people in Kaduna Central Senatorial District, the Uba Sani Foundation in partnership with the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) organized a two-day sensitization program for critical stakeholders across the seven LGA's of the District.

The engagement had in attendance Council Chairmen, District Heads, religious leaders (representatives of JNI and CAN), National Youth Council of Nigeria (NYCN) officials, leaders of Persons with Disabilities organizations, political leaders, youths, and women leaders across the seven local government areas of the senator's constituency.

The program is the result of long and strenuous efforts by the Senator to ensure that the people of Kaduna Central Senatorial District in particular, and the North in general avail themselves of the opportunities offered by the Federal Government's Social Intervention Programmes. It was observed that in successive programs majority of the people could not benefit because they had no bank accounts and had little or no knowledge of how to access loan facilities. Instead of merely agonizing over the unfortunate situation, the Distinguished Senator took steps to remedy the situation, thus the sensitization program.

The target of the Foundation is to get about 1 million people to open bank accounts and acquire financial literacy in Kaduna State, and to get 4 million people in the North West to open bank accounts at no cost.

Bills & Vlotions Sponsored By Senator Uba Sani At The 9th Senate



1. Banks and Other Financial Institutions (Repeal & Re-Enactment) Act, 2020

This Act was sponsored to amongst other things, update obsolete banking regulations, properly regulate the activities of Financial Technology companies (FinTech's) and strengthen Nigeria's financial sector to a new height post-COVID 19.

STATUS: The Act was signed into law by President Muhammadu Buhari on 12th November, 2020.

2. Asset Management Corporation of Nigeria Act (Amendment No.3) Act 2021

This Act was sponsored to remove the impediments hampering AMCON's optimal performance and checkmate individuals who derive joy in sabotaging the economy through toxic loans. The Act also allows AMCON to utilize the Credit Tribunal created under the BOFIA Act 2020 to recover loans which will speed up the loan dispute resolution cases in AMCON.

STATUS: The Act was signed into law by President Muhammadu Buhari on 12th November, 2021.

3. Federal Medical Centre, Rigasa, Kaduna State (est. etc.) Bill, 2019

This Bill was sponsored in response to the cries of constituents in Rigasa, a densely populated area in the state, who watch helplessly as sick persons especially women and children die on a daily basis due to lack of well-equipped healthcare centres. When operational, the centre will provide facilities for diagnosis, preventive, curative and rehabilitative service in medical treatment.

STATUS: The Bill has been passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives. The Bill has been transmitted to Mr. President Muhammadu Buhari for Presidential Assent.

4. Fire Arms Act Cap F28 LFN, 2004 (Amendment) Bill 2021

This Bill seeks to increase the imposition of fines for offences and provide for the destruction of firearms illegally imported into the country or in possession of individuals without valid license. The Bill is geared towards curtailing the circulation of illegal firearms in the country and restoring peace to our troubled communities.

STATUS: The Bill has been passed by the Senate and is currently before the House of Representatives for concurrence.

5. Federal College of Education Giwa, Kaduna State (est. etc.) Bill, 2019

The Bill was sponsored in the realization of the fact that the crisis in the education sector cannot be effectively tackled if priority attention is not given to the production of professional and quality teachers.

STATUS: The Bill has been passed by the Senate and is currently before the House of Representatives for concurrence.

6. Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill 2020 This Bill was sponsored to provide for the appointment of judges by State Governors on the recommendation of the State Judicial Service Commission so. as to aid in the speedy dispensation of justice.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

7. Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill 2020 This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 to amongst other provisions establish State Police Force in the 36 states of the Federation, change the name of the Police Service Commission to the Federal Police Service Commission, establish the State Police Service Commission and amend the Second and Third Schedules of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999.



STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

8. Foreign Exchange (Control & Monitoring) Act 2004 (Repeal and Re-Enactment) Bill 2020

This Bill was sponsored to bridge the widening gap in the exchange rate as well as tackle the issue of rising inflation due to high cost of imports. Cost of goods and services increase because many cost items are incurred at black market rates while foreign currency revenue will be reported at the lower interbank rates resulting in lower tax payments.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

9. National Human Rights Commission Act (Amendment) Bill 2020

This Bill seeks to alter the National Human Rights Commission (Amendment) Act, 2010, to amongst other provisions include representatives of the youth and Persons with Disability (PWDs) in the composition of the Governing Council of the National Human Rights Commission so as to ensure the rights and interests of these categories of persons are adequately represented at the national level.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

10. NDLEA Act CAP NO.3 LFN 2004 (Amendment) Bill 2020

This Bill was sponsored to strengthen the National Drug Law Enforcement Agency in tackling the growing rate of drug abuse in Nigeria especially in the North and eliminating the growing, processing, manufacturing, selling, exporting and trafficking of hard drugs.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

11. Police Service Commission Act 2001 (Repeal and Re-Enactment) Bill, 2020 This Bill seeks to repeal the Police Service Commission Act 2001 and enact the Federal Police Service Commission (Est. Etc.) Bill, to amongst other provisions establish a Commission which shall be charged with discipline of all officers except in state police force and to dismiss and exercise disciplinary control over any person holding office in the Nigeria Police Force (other than the inspector-general of police).

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

12. Institute of Information and Communication Technology Kaduna South (Est., Etc.) Bill 2020

This Bill was sponsored to improve the education standards in Kaduna State in terms of Information and Communication Technology (ICT), as well as place Northern Nigeria in a position to take full advantage of globalization and the emerging digital economy.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

13. Nigeria Police Act (Amendment) Bill, 2020

This Bill seeks to alter the Nigeria Police Act 2020 to amongst other provisions establish an operational structure for State Police Force in the 36 states of the Federation, change the name of the Police Service Commission to the Federal Police Service Commission, and address new issues that are not covered under the Nigeria Police Act 2020.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing



14. State Police Service Commission (Establishment) Bill, 2020

This Bill seeks to enact the State Police Service Commission (Est. Etc.) Bill to amongst other provisions establish a Commission which shall be charged with discipline of all officers except in state police force and to dismiss and exercise disciplinary control over any person holding office in the State Police Force (other than the Commissioner of Police).

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

15. Care and Protection of Child Parents Bill, 2019

This Bill was sponsored to provide succour to child parents and create a platform where they can be reintegrated into society after childbirth and still fulfil their dreams.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

16. Federal College of Forestry Technology and Research, Birnin-Gwari, Kaduna State (est. etc.) Bill, 2019

This Bill was sponsored to tap into the potentials of forestry technology and educate the youth in Kaduna State on the opportunities that are derivable from investing in this largely untapped industry.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

17. The University of Technology Kaduna State (est. etc.) Bill, 2019

This Bill which seeks to convert Kaduna State Polytechnic into a University, was primarily sponsored in a bid to reposition the institution so it can contribute effectively to the production of skilled manpower needed for Nigeria's industrialization.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

18. Factoring, Assignment and Receivables Financing Bill, 2021

This Bill was sponsored to regulate factoring, the purchase of receivables, as well as the establishment, operation and control of business operations of organizations engaged in factoring and receivables financing. It seeks to establish principles and adopt rules relating to the assignment of receivables in order to create certainty and transparency and promote the modernization of the law. The Bill also seeks to ensure adequate protection for the interests of debtors in order to promote the availability of capital and credit and to also facilitate domestic and international trade.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

19. Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Act Cap M23 Cap M23 LFN 2004 (Amendment) Bill, 2021

This Bill seeks to increase the imposition of fines for offences and setting a higher standard of accountability for Motor vehicle users to financially protect Nigerians against any third-party damage, loss of property, death or bodily injury caused to the third party.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

20. Recovery of Public Property (Special Provisions) Act Cap R4 LFN 2004 (Repeal) Bill, 2021

This Bill seeks to repeal the principal act as same has become inconsistent with the provisions of the constitution.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing



21. Agricultural and Rural Management Training Institute, Chikum (Establishment) Bill, 2021

This Bill seeks to amend the Agricultural and Rural Management Training Institute Act, Cap. A.10, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to allow Federal Colleges of Technology and Federal Polytechnics in Nigeria participate in the Board of the Institute.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

22. Act Authentication Act Cap A2 LFN 2004 (Amendment) Bill, 2021

This Bill seeks to amend the Acts Authentication Act, Cap. A2, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 to provide for a timeframe for the performance of some functions of the Clerk of the National Assembly.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

23. Arbitration and Conciliation Act Cap A18 LFN 2004 (Amendment) Bill 2021

This Bill seeks to amend the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, Cap. A18, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to ensure the constitutional rights of parties in Arbitration are guaranteed.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

24. Criminal Code Act Cap C38 LFN 2004 (Amendment) Bill 2021

This Bill seeks to amend the Criminal Code Act, Cap. C38, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to aid access to information from public institutions.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

25. Freedom of Information Act 2010 (Amendment Bill) 2022

This Bill seeks to remove the bureaucratic bottlenecks that hinders access to information from government institutions by the public.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

26. Child Rights Act 2003 (Amendment) Bill, 2022

This Bill seeks to amend the Child Rights Act, Cap. C23, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to stop the maltreating of children by parents, teachers, counsellors, legal guardians and juvenile correctional centers and other related matters.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

27. Cybercrimes (Prohibition, Prevention Etc.,) Act, 2015 (Amendment) Bill 2022

This Bill seeks to amend the Cybercrimes (Prohibition, Prevention Etc.) Act (Amendment) Bill 2022 to criminalize the non-consensual creation of nude or sexual images and provide for the offence of Image Based Sexual Abuse and for related matters.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

28. Compulsory Treatment and Care for Victims of Gunshots Act 2017 (Amendment) Bill 2022

This Bill seeks to preserve the life of gunshot victims by removing obstacles that prevent quick medical attention to them. The Bill also seeks to balance the desire of persons injured by gunshot to receive medical attention as soon as possible, with the need to protect hospitals, doctors and even volunteers who attend to gunshot victims.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing



29. Federal Airport Authority of Nigeria Act (Amendment) Bill 2022 (S.B 956)

This Bill seeks to amend the Federal Airport Authority of Nigeria Act, Cap. F5, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to make the Board of the agency more robust and effective by adding persons to the Board who can elevate Nigerian Airports to best international standards and other related matters.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

30. Trustee Investment Act (Amendment) Bill 2022 (S.B 1027)

This Bill seeks to amend the Trustee Investment Act to provide mechanism for facilitating the investment of trust and other funds in issued securities including mortgages backed securities and secondary mortgage transactions.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

31. Nigeria International Financial Centre (Establishment) Bill 2022 (S.B 1045)

This Bill seeks to establish the Nigeria International Financial Centre (NIFC) which will act as an international gateway for capital and investments, driven by technology and payment system infrastructure.

STATUS: The bill has passed the first reading and is progressing

32. Nigeria Deposit Insurance Corporation (Repeal & Re – enactment) Bill 2022 (S.B 1055)

This Bill seeks to among other things, repeal the Nigeria Deposit Insurance Corporation Act 2006 and replace it with a new Act that provides for the Nigeria Deposit Insurance Corporation as the insurer of all insurable deposit liabilities of insured institutions.

STATUS: The Bill has successfully passed 1st and 2nd Reading at the Senate. This was after a well attended Public hearing hosted to ensure the needed legislative framework for the bill. The bill is currently at the Report stage of the Senate, waiting to be laid by the Senate Committee on Banking, Insurance and other Financial Institutions.
